

General Information:

The 2008 USA Cycling Ohio State Junior Road Race Championship is a *junior only* road race event August 16th, 2007 in Zanesfield, Ohio. The course is challenging enough for good racing, but not so hard as to be discouraging.

While we are taking every effort to make this the premier junior road race event in Ohio, it is recommended that this not be a first road race experience for the junior racer.

There will be official support vehicles for all categories and rider chaperones for the youngest fields, in addition to a full complement of course marshals and the support of the Logan County Sherriff.

Registration for the Zanesfield Road Race will be through BikeReg.com, and the fields will be:

Male 10-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18

Female 10-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18

All attempts will be made to limit the combining of fields, but in the event of low turnout, the LAJORS recommended fields will be used.

You can make it a weekend of junior racing in Central Ohio by combining this race with the Buckeye Criterium Sunday on the campus of The Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio. There is LAJORS and all USAC category racing on a great criterium course, used for many years for collegiate racing. 43311, USA

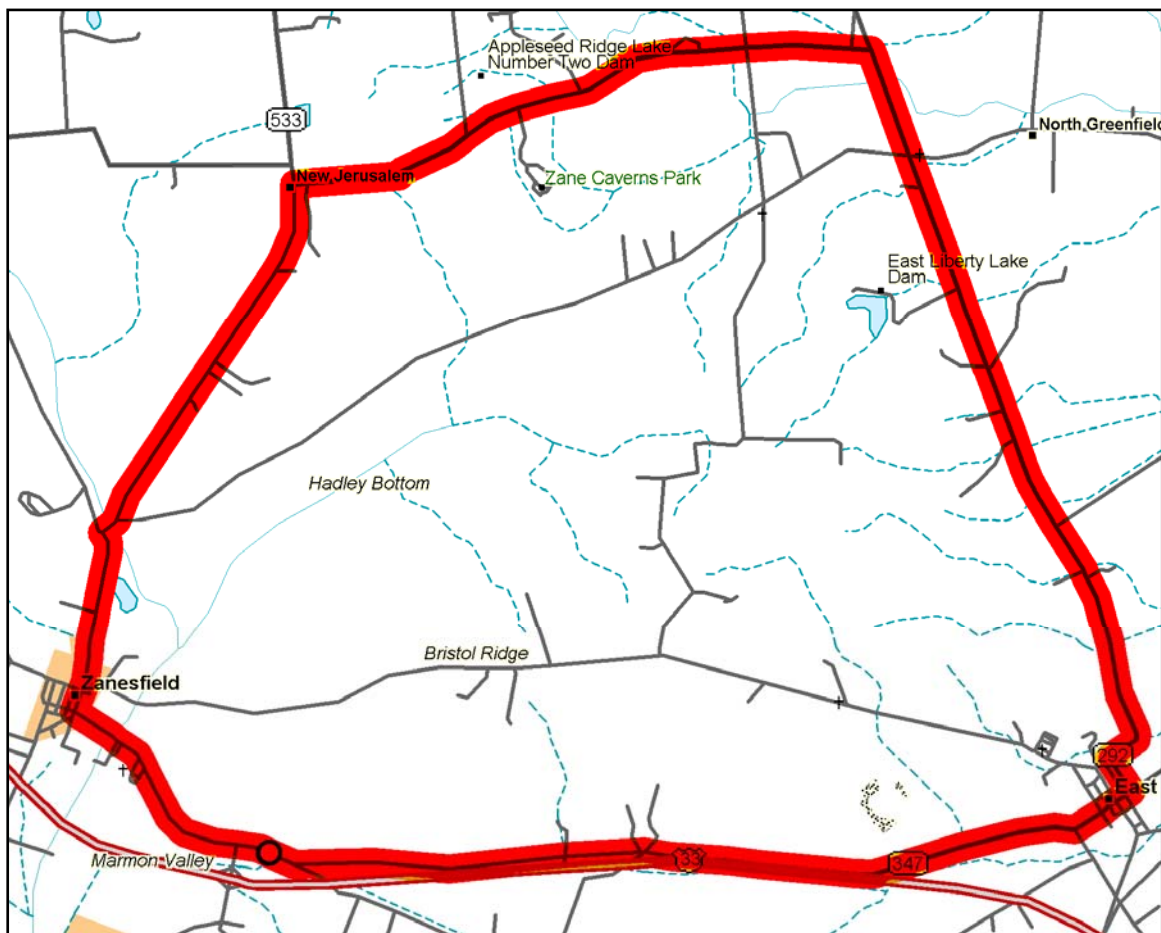
This is also the area for parking and where restroom facilities will be located.
